This year, for the first time, two awards were presented at the Awards Banquet held during the course of the Annual Meeting.

The new award, known as the Outstanding Project Award, was presented to Richard Goettle, Inc. The award was inscribed *Richard Goettle, Inc. - Underpinning & Earthquake Isolation Project - State Building, Columbia, South Carolina*. Accepting the award on behalf of Richard Goettle, Inc., was Larry Rayburn, Goettle president. Larry acknowledged the contribution of job staff and workers to an unusual but successful project accomplished under difficult working conditions. To illustrate the nature of the project, he showed a number of slides taken at various stages of construction.
