- **December 9, 2011: Interested authors should submit an abstract of not more than 300 words online at www.dfi2012submissions.org. Abstract document should include author names, affiliations and contact information. If you are interested in serving as a panelist on a specific topic, please indicate the panel topic in the abstract document.**
- January 13, 2012: Authors will be notified as to whether or not they have been selected to submit a draft paper
- March 23, 2012: Draft papers due
- May 18, 2012: Paper reviews complete; decision on presentation status and comments to be returned to authors
- July 27, 2012: Final paper due – 10 page limit
